Spiranthes aestivalis Rich.

DESCRIPTION

Storage root geophyte, narrow-lanceolate leaves. Inflorescence spiral. Perigone green-veined outside, otherwise white, glandular-hairy. Lip white, curved downward, undivided, with curly margin.

HABITAT

Calcareous lowland moorland communities and siliceous vegetation, on calcareous, nutrient-poor calcareous tufa
