Anacamptis sancta (L.) R.M. Bateman & al.

DESCRIPTION

Orchid with a cylindrical inflorescence, formed by uniformly coloured, unspotted flowers.

HABITAT

Phrygana, short grassland, scrub and open woodland, on dry, calcareous substrates.

DISTRIBUTION

East Mediterranean: Greece, Cyprus, Turkey, southwards to Jordan and Syria, through Lebanon and Israel.





DANGER

Residential & commercial development (housing & urban areas; tourism & recreation areas), agriculture (annual & perennial non-timber crops; livestock farming & ranching), biological resource use (plant gathering).
