

# Baumann's orchid

*Dactylorhiza baumanniana* J. Hölz. & Künkele

## DESCRIPTION

Perennial plant with densely spotted leaves. Flowers dark magenta to pale lilac, the lip spreading and spotted with darker dots and lines.

## HABITAT

Damp places in marshes, stream banks, on neutral to acidic substrates.

## DISTRIBUTION

Reported only from Greece and southern Bulgaria.



## DANGER

Residential & commercial development (housing & urban areas; tourism & recreation areas), agriculture (livestock farming & ranching), biological resource use (plant gathering), pollution (domestic & urban wastewater), climate change & severe weather (droughts).
