

Reinhold's bee-orchid

Ophrys reinholdii H. Fleischm.

DESCRIPTION

Plant with 2-8 flowers. Sepals and upper petals pink, flushed with green. Median lip blackish-purple with hairy lateral lobes and usually white pattern in the center.

HABITAT

Woodland, phrygana, grassland and olive groves.

DISTRIBUTION

From Albania to Iran, through Greece, Turkey, Cyprus and Iraq.



DANGER

Residential & commercial development (housing & urban areas; tourism & recreation areas), biological resource use (plant gathering), human intrusions & disturbance (work & other activities).
